

The Result:

This race is still evolving. George Weaver came in like a Wesley Ward clone with three top contenders, two of which showed early speed. "B" Teamer **BIG EVS** was the super-hyped European and 2nd fave. The Crushers had doubts that a Euro could keep up with the domestic speedsters...they never see early fractions like those displayed in U.S. races at 5f. **BIG EVS** did keep up and then powered to the lead with just enough left to hold off two other Euro closers. The Euros were announcing that they were a force to be reckoned with.

The Result:

In the previous eight SA-hosted Juv Fillies, SoCal homers took 7 of those editions. And this year, the media hype was handing over an 8th victory with the highly-touted TAMARA. The Crushers listed her in the CRUSHING ZONE but were confident she would get beat. The East Coast invaders were led by Pletcher's CANDIED and Mott's JUST FYI. Both trainers had previously struggled at SA. Crusher Mazur was looking for a NOW-filly longshot. Maybe ACCOMMODATE EVA would zip to the lead and never look back. Or maybe SCALABLE would rally past the speed to become the first maiden winner of this race. In the end it was CRUSHING ZONER and "A" TEAMER JUST FYI narrowly besting longshot invader JODY'S PRIDE. JUST FYI fit the NOW FILLY criteria. We just had to have faith that Mott could get off the schneid in SA.

The Result:

The history of this race is pretty straight forward: stick with the domestics coming out of the Ms. Grillo, Natalma and maybe the Jessamine. Chad Brown had won 4 of the last 8 editions. Although a Euro won last year, they usually don't make an impact. Yet, in this edition, Euros **PORTA FORTUNA (7-2)** and **CARLA'S WAY (5-1)** were being bet. Meanwhile Brown's **HARD TO JUSTIFY** was slipping away at 9-1. That was Crusher Mazur's **MOST LIKELY**.

And Mazur had scored before in this race by playing the *Twilight Zone* rerun of the Ms. Grillo in the exacta and trifecta. He needed **LIFE'S AN AUDIBLE (29-1)** and **GALA BRAND (20-1)** to hit the board for the **CRUSH**. Almost. **HARD TO JUSTIFY** won but had to fend off 2nd fave **PORTA FORTUNA** with favorite **SHE FEELS PRETTY** 3rd. Brown at 9-1! Ms. Grillo produces. SoCals are nowhere to be found.

The Result:

Bob Baffet (3) and Todd Pletcher (3) saddled 6 of the 9 starters with Pletcher's **LOCKED** and Baffert's **MUTH** the top two faves. **CRUSHER MAZUR'S** Pick 6 was alive with those two and Champagne winner **TIMBER LAKE**. Another hopeful, **THE WINE STEWARD**, was a late scratch. In Mazur's Pick 5, he included all the Bafferts and Pletchers, the "no-brainer" approach.

It looked like Baffert's trio would try to control the pace. They didn't. Instead Champagne refugee **GENERAL PARTNER** took the early lead and Pletcher's longest shot—**FIERCENESS (19-1)**—stalked. **MUTH** made a solid move but **FIERCENESS** pulled away for an impressive upset. **FIERCENESS** made history by becoming the first Juvenile winner to show a major form reversal in his final prep (finished 7th, 20 lengths back in the Champagne).

The Result:

Historically, this race runs the exact opposite of the fillies counterpart: the Euros dominate. Other profile points: (1) If not a Euro than maybe a domestic from the Pilgrim; (2) never been a wire winner; and (3) never been a SoCal-based winner.

The entire Euro contingent was a trio trained by Aidan O'Brien. RIVER TIBER looked best. QUESTIONABLE was, well, questionable and MOUNTAIN BEAR looked like a PRETENDER. AGATE ROAD and FULMINEO exited the Pilgrim. Domestic MY BOY PRINCE was lone speed coming out of the Summer (produced 1 winner in '10 and none since). He was bet down to 5-1. CAN GROUP and TOK TOK exited the Bourbon...that prep produced the first Juv Turf winner and none since. ENDLESSLY and STAY HOT were the SoCal reps, the latter bet down to 5-1.

RIVER TIBER was a late scratch. The punters pounded UNQUESTIONABLE down to 3-2. They got it right. He won impressively but the surprise was from MOUNTAIN BEAR (22-1) getting up for the place. Note the exacta paid just \$38 for a buck. Again, the race historical profiles produced and that allowed Crusher Mazur to cash out a Pick 5. Onward to Saturday.
