Advanced Notice	16-Jan	3	stumbled at the start and stuck inside to mid turn made a sharp move entering but was just ridden out behind the long gone lead pair.
Alarm The C.E.O.	18-Jan	2	not sent early was stopped entering the turn and steadied again in mid stretch, was just ridden out late when in tight again
Aristocat	11-Jan	6	big strong looking guy was hurt by the post, raced inside to the turn, would not go up the open rail but rallied well when taken outside
Bat Mobile	9-Jan	6	bet down 007 firster, sat in behind the lead pack, eased out entering and motored down the center of the track for an easy win
Beyond the Waves	11-Jan	8	right at home dealing with French fractions was delayed in turn traffic but split horses late and was getting to the long gone winner
Blossum	16-Jan	7	showed no speed and appeared to be prepping, made a long wide run entering but was shut off in mid stretch, then finished up in hand when clear
Boastful	8-Jan	9	checked early then stuck between horses to mid turn, was steadied entering and again in mid stretch, then finished up well
Boastful	24-Jan	9	ourun badly in the first half, went up widest entering and wore down the tripping fave in the last jump; we'll stay with him.
Canadian Peso	20-Jan	7	out quicked this group widest into the first turn, showed speed while in hand then drew off when pressured mid turn-could be any kind
Chalmette	16-Jan	7	hard held early while rank, made a big run inside nearing the turn but was stopped cold, then made a late run inside and between horses
Charge	9-Jan	8	hard held every step til the final 1/16th in a slowly run race made a bold run between horses and was fastest at the wire and out.
Charge and Send	11-Jan	4	bounced around early and then steadied near the stretch was just ridden out at end...expect a drop in class.
Chaya	5-Jan	4	missed the break and was not hustled to catch up, went widest in the turn and showed a nice turn of foot in deep stretch and out
Cherokee Promise	3-Jan	4	checked at the break and then restrained inside til mid turn, put in a solid stretch run under no pressure; ready for the turf now.
Coalition	16-Jan	10	did everthing wrong and won: broke thru before, rank early, blocked to mid stretch, changed lanes twice and won in hand; were they that bad or is he sumthin'?
Countessa	25-Jan	11	pulling early and hard held, was making a run nearing the turn when checked hard and nearly fell, was moving again in deep stretch
Court Notes	3-Jan	10	just working- allowed to drop far back, got no urging until inside the stretch, then responded like a fit horse- big effort coming
Cozzening	24-Jan	6	had the look of a public work- outrun early put in one run entering and another in deep stretch- we look for turf soon

El Domenico	10-Jan	6	stuck on the rail every step got pinned mid race and shuffled back entering and put in a strong late run; takes his improved form to new barn
Elusive Gentleman	11-Jan	9	got caught in traffic early and forced to steady thru the entire turn was not hard ridden late
Exclusive Run	5-Jan	8	just working in this one; trailed until entering then put a strong run late widest- will be a price even with a drop
Expected Hour	20-Jan	5	bumped at the start and rank in the early running behind the lead pair, was taken back mid turn and came between horses in deep stretch
Father Martin	20-Jan	3	checked at the start and rushed up between horses nearing the turn was stopped again, went wide entering but the winner was gone and was just ridden out
Fleet Deed	3-Jan	2	away slowly and in traffic was set down entering and finished well moving between horses late; solid great white north trainer
Friendly Man	23-Jan	6	broke in a tangle on the bad rail, followed the flow to mid turn when he went outside and put in a solid furlong, was not hard ridden late
Funny Cide	18-Jan	10	arrived 12 wide in the first turn, pulled Jose to the lead group 8 wide down the back, was with the winner through the turn but tired late.
Greatness	19-Jan	9	off a step slowly and then the nightmare began: boxed in and checked before the turn found no room in the stretch but was out best
Green Colony	25-Jan	3	slick looking firster was just working in this one; put in a nice run in mid stretch and was out in hand
Green Knight	24-Jan	5	new tactics: not encouraged early, began picking off horses in the turn and put in a strong finish along the rail and out
Greg's Deck	24-Jan	1	getting close to a serious try: walked along far back; took two strokes entering and spinted home

Keen Intelligence	11-Jan	3	up a class off the claim and cautiously ridden, let the field get away in the far turn then reponded well to pressure late to finish fastest
Las Brisas Girl	5-Jan	1	running too short here; they got away from her in the turn but she responded to pressure nicely late- will stretch out to win
Las Brisas Girl	20-Jan	2	bumped early then steered inside, made a run in mid turn, was not used in the late run..give her one more

Lilah	9-Jan	9	oops! Away slowly then stuck inside into the turn, had no room in mid stretch but overcame the rider for a solid 2nd
Lion Tamer	4-Jan	5	hesitated again at the break, caught the field quickly, was steadied mid turn then shot into the lead entering-top miler in the making
Magic Peak	10-Jan	8	lightly raced layed-off router was out run early and restrained through the half, was set down in mid stretch and finished well
Martino's Gold	17-Jan	1	bottom claimer got bounced around early and steadied in behind the wire winner every step, came out in deep stretch too late
Mic Mac	18-Jan	6	got no help in this one, hustled up into traffic twice early, finally got room in deep stretch and closed fastest
My Dear Jazz	18-Jan	4	bet down fave, bobbed at the start and hustled to get position early, was stuck inside on the rail to mid stretch and not hard ridden late
My Dream	8-Jan	3	squeezed to the back early, found a spot on the dull rail but was walled up to mid stretch when he put in a long run to just miss
Mystical Blues	10-Jan	2	ran down a long gone rabbit with an eye catching stretch and came back looking sharp and ready for more;

Quick Draw	4-Jan	4	race ready big guy, spotted the leaders five coming away, got to the lead on the dead rail, was passed but came again deep when pressured
Rare Endeavour	22-Jan	4	outgunned in the early going made a strong mid race move to get through the field and was not pressured as the lead pair stole away
Reduit	4-Jan	11	not set up for a stone closer- very slow until the last quarter; still this guy closed strong and was not hard used
Regal Watch	18-Jan	11	bounced around early was forced wide in the turn and just ridden out late- needs a drop but has a bad line now for a pricey try
Remind	22-Jan	6	caught outside every step was used once to get to the front and again entering while turning in a solid last 1/8th in hand. Follow him up.
Saint Soarby	25-Jan	4	missed the break and then held off the pace wide, was not allowed to run in the backstretch and was not used late- look for speed in next
Saint Verre	11-Jan	10	strong anti-profile late run by noted route speedster: hard held early was sent up five wide in mid turn and finished like a fit horse
Scott	11-Jan	7	nervous in the gate and bumped leaving was sawed off in turn one, then rank between horses but got out mid turn and was still tying late
Sensationalplace	9-Jan	2	easiest kind of winner, out first, relaxed nicely when pressed early, came away in the turn and won with a ton left.
Shesfastbutnoteasy	12-Jan	11	out of the one hole was bumped early and then stuck behind a wall thru the turn, was clear late and finished well in hand
Sign Of Greatness	20-Jan	7	broke well but was pulled in behind the wiring winner showing swift fractions, was shuffled back in the turn but finished up well outside
Silver Nitric	23-Jan	2	improved outing off the pace: followed in hand, steadied entering then split horses, took a bump, changed lanes and was out best
Silver Squire	3-Jan	9	little guy was not urged early but began to pick them off in mid turn, steadied in mid stretch was going fastest at end- goes on
Spin Control	19-Jan	8	held off the fast opening quarter, made a long run through the turn but tired between fillies in the late going;has more speed than is showing.

Watch Your Pennies	12-Jan	8	going too short here he found his stride entering, changed lanes late and was out fastest- crying out for more ground
What A Price	19-Jan	7	was caught in a jam in the first turn, then worked to the outside entering and put in a strong late run as the winner bore out in front of him
Who Can Tell	19-Jan	4	little firster delayed the start then broke last, showed speed catching field but was inside the lead pair and was not encouraged in the stretch
Wish It Were	25-Jan	6	jostled and badly outrun in the early going, was set down in mid turn, taken outside entering and was wearing the leaders down at the end
